CHRISTIANITY EXPLAINED

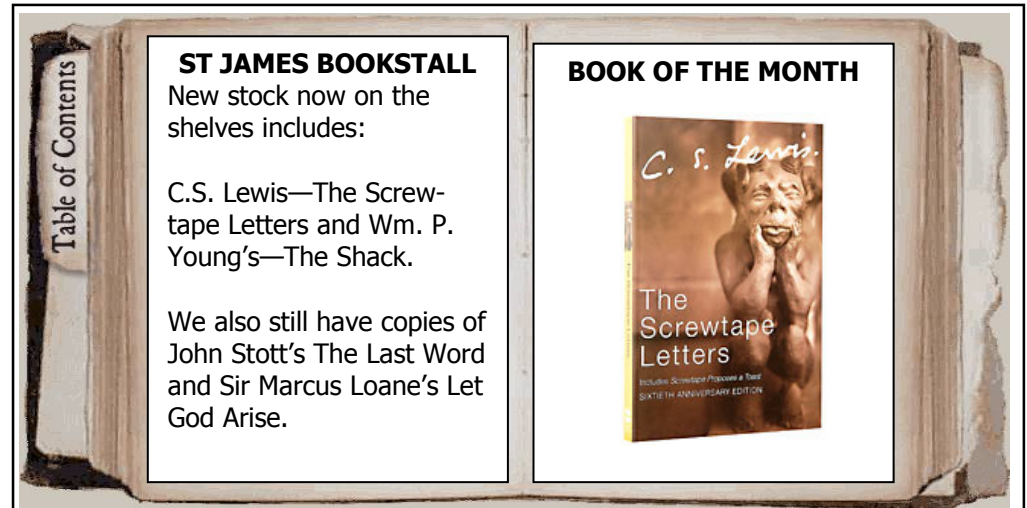
