

## Study 1 - Jonah 1:1-16 The Flight of Jonah

**Q1.** (0) Read vv1-3. Assuming that Jonah was in Israel when he received The Lord's call (maybe he was at home in Gath Hepher), use a map to compare what Jonah was commanded to do & what he actually did.

(NB. Tarshish is thought to be on the coast of modern Spain or the coast of the region of Cilicia)

**Q2.** (0) Read through Jonah 1:1-16 and complete this table...

Q3. (I) How would you summarise Jonah's attitude toward the Lord?

How would you summarise the Sailors' attitude toward the Lord?

**Q4.** (I) From vv1-16, what truths about the Lord are revealed?

**Q5.** (I) What words can you suggest to describe the appropriate response to a god with the qualities listed in Q4?

**Q6.** (I) Why do you think Jonah thought he could avoid the Lord's command? When can Christians be just like Jonah?

**Q7.** (A) Jonah didn't trust the Lord's wisdom and plans. How is our trust connected to our obedience? What might this connection suggest toward growing a more obedient heart? Romans 8:30-32 might help.

**Q8.** (A) **Share & Pray** about situations where, in future, you can respond better to our powerful, Sovereign Lord God.
